like hibernating animals, trees store food

(nutrients) for winter. in summer, trees are busy growing new leaves while in the winter, the trees are focused on growing roots.

planting trees in winter helps them really put down roots. any subsequent cold weather will, if the tree is well-cared for, actually "harden off" the tree and

help it become stronger and hardier. this gives trees a head start with wellrooted plants supporting more vigorous top growth in the next seasons.

remember, soil quality is a key factor for planting, and just as important as the tree itself. be sure to follow our tree planting guidelines.


